“People ball”

“People ball” is played on the volleyball court without a net. There must be consisting of two teams (10-15 players).

Each team is on one half of the pitch and one player is sent the ball to the opponents' half.

The ball is put into the play throwing through across the opponents pitch.

If a player of one team catches it, he/she throws it to the other half of the team, trying to get to the opponents player. The player has been beaten, if so he/she goes out of play. If he/she catches the ball on the fly and throws back trying to get to the opponent.

So changing the order of throws and the growing number of players are out of the game. The winner is this team who beat all opponents.

“It is me”

The players stand in a circle. The player in the center of the circle calls two names of other participants. Whose names are called, shouted: "This is - me" - and change places. The player in the center should take the empty place. Who is left without a place - becomes the person in the center of the circle.
